Complete in Freshman and Sophomore Years	Leader-Servant	SER 103	Complete in first year at Southern Virginia. Not required of students who enrolled at Southern Virginia before fall 2007.	
	Freshman Writing	ENG 120	Complete in freshman year. Take ENG 110 first if you scored below 21 on ACT verbal or below 501 on SAT verbal.	
	Philosophy	LIB 110, PHI 210, or PHI 215	Take LIB 110. PHI 210 and 215 were available before fall 2007.	
	American Republic	LIB 120, HIS 120, or HIS 220	Take LIB 120. HIS 120 was available before spring 2009; HIS 220 was available before fall 2007.	
	Literature	LIB 130, ENG 210, or ENG 215	Take LIB 130. ENG 210 and 215 were available before fall 2007.	
	History of the Arts	ART 210, ART 215, HUM 210, HUM 215, MUS 210, or THE 215	Take one.	
	Political Heritage	HIS 210, HIS 215, or POL 213	Take one.	
	Mathematics	MAT 114, 115, 206, 221, 241, 242, CSC 213, or PHI 223	Take one. CSC 213 and PHI 223 satisfy this requirement only for students who scored 28 on ACT math or 615 on SAT math.	
	Life Science	BIO 114, 126, 128, 201, 211, 212, or 228	Take one. BIO 201 is primarily for biology majors and minors and pre-med/pre-health students. BIO 126 & 128 are non-lab.	
	Physical Science	CHE 114 or 201, or PHY 114, 117, 126, or 201	Take one. CHE 201 is primarily for biology majors, chemistry minors, and pre-med/pre-health students. PHY 126 is non-lab.	
	Science Lab	One of the above life or physical science courses must have a lab component.	BIO 114, CHE 114, and PHY 114 are lab science courses designed for non-science majors.	
	1 st Year Foreign Language	FRE 102, GER 102, GRK 102, LAT 102, SPN 102, or competency exam	Take 101 before 102 if starting from scratch. If not, contact the Registrar's Office to take a placement test.	
	Physical Activity 1	A course from PER 100–199, 231, 232, or (for varsity or JV athletes) 259R	Take three physical activity courses and PER 143 before graduating. Two of these four courses must be completed by the end of the sophomore year. Physical activity courses marked "R" may be taken twice for Core credit.	
Physical Activity 2	A course from PER 100–199, 231, 232, or (for varsity or JV athletes) 259R			
Information Literacy	LIB 203 Information Literacy (replaces CSC 103 Technology Tools after fall 2008)	Recommended for completion by the end of the sophomore year. LIB 203 is not required if you completed CSC or ISD 103.		
Complete in Any Year	Social Sciences	ECN 210 or 215, EDU 250, FCD 210 or 250, POL 223 or 233, or PSY 201	Take one. The social sciences elective is not required of students who enrolled at Southern Virginia before fall 2007.	
	Fine Arts	ART 113, 120, 130, 214, 223, 227, 230, or 240; MUS 108, 129R, 139, 151, or 167; or THE 106 or 110	Take one. The fine arts elective is not required of students who enrolled at Southern Virginia before fall 2007.	
	2 nd Year Foreign Language	FRE 202, GER 202, GRK 202, LAT 202, SPN 202, or competency exam	Unless you have some knowledge of the language, you will need to take 101, 102, and/or 201 first.	
	Physical Activity 3	A course from PER 100–199, 231, 232, or (for varsity or JV athletes) 259R	Take three physical activity courses and PER 143 before graduating. Two of these four courses must be completed by the end of the sophomore year. Physical activity courses marked "R" may be taken twice for Core credit.	
	Physical Activity 4	A course from PER 100–199, 231, 232, or (for varsity or JV athletes) 259R		
Senior Year	Advanced Writing	Complete a senior paper in your major or, if your major has no senior paper, write a 3,000-word paper for an upper-division course. The paper must satisfy the style standard of the course's discipline and be revised to account for the instructor's comments. File the faculty-approved paper with the Registrar's Office.		
	Senior Seminar	Take LIB 490 in your last year unless you completed one of the following pairs before fall 2007: ART 210 & 215, ENG 210 & 215, HIS 210 & 215, PHI 210 & 215, or MUS 210 & THE 215. If you did, LIB 490 is waived.
