APPLICATION ABC'S:

WHEN APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS BE...

- **Authentic!** Seek and apply for scholarships based on your demographic information, culture, religion, etc.. Scholarship foundations are looking for someone like you, guaranteed.
- **Bold!** Scholarship foundations want to invest in your potential. Actively document your achievements, awards, extracurricular activities, volunteer hours, etc.
- **Creative!** Reach out to local businesses, family workplaces, high school alumni networks, community foundations, national service organizations, hobby and enthusiast groups -- ask around!
- **Diligent!** Be aware of deadlines and meet them, write essays thoughtfully, carefully revise-- For all you do, put your heart into it, and made each application the best it can be.

APPLICATION ABC'S

SCHOLARSHIPS: WHEN? HOW?

- **Early!** Give yourself ample time to research scholarships, gather necessary documents, and write thoughtfully. Rushing leads to mistakes.
- **Frequently!** Make it a routine-- apply as consistently as time will allow, and apply year round for the most promising results. This way, you will be more aware, stay calm, and be less burnt-out.
- **Generously!** Quantify your impact by sharing specific data, metrics, and anecdotes, and contact people to who could give you high recommendation, e.g. a favorite teacher, church leader, etc.
